



FOAL BORN IN FRANCE MARE TO BE COVERED IN FRANCE

- → Birth in France
- → Birth declared with the French National Stud
- → Identification of the foal in France
- → Foal can travel abroad on a temporary visa for a maximum of 1 month

Non exhaustive information, for more detail refer to Article 86 of the France Galop's racing rules

- → Foal must be bred in France until the 1st June N+1
- → The mare must not leave France more than 180 days during the birth year of the foal

FOAL BORN IN FRANCE MARE TO BE COVERED ABROAD

- → Birth in France
- → OBLIGATIONS BEFORE LEAVING FRANCE:
- 1/ Birth declared with the French Stud-Book
- 2/ Identification of the foal in France
- 3/ Temporary export certificate organised with France Galop *

- → EXIT PERIOD: max 180 days
- → Dam & foal must be back before the 15th July N
- → Foal must stay in France from his return until the 1st June N+1, exit period for the foal can't exceed 1 month
- → Transport documents + hosting certificate of the French Stud Farm must be forwarded to France Galop before 31st December N+1

* at the latest, one month after the exportation


FOAL BORN ABROAD MARE TO BE COVERED ABROAD

- → Mare in foal can only leave France from the 15th December N-1. Temporary export certificate organised with France Galop prior to departure or during the following leaving month
- → Birth abroad
- → Birth declared with the concerned Stud Book, identification of the foal in the birth country
- → EXIT PERIOD: max 180 days
- → Dam & foal must be back before the 15th July N
- → Foal must stay in France from his return until the 1st June N+1, exit period for the foal can't exceed 1 month
- → Transport documents + hosting certificate of the French Stud Farm must be forwarded to France Galop before 31st December N+1

N-1: foal conception year
 N: foal age / foal birth
 N+1: yearling age

in all races in France* (excluding premiums). Apply to horses that are less than 10vos except in Group 1, 2, 3 and Listed below: L. Prix Gaston de Bataille Grand Cross-Country de Pau, L. Prix Anjou-Loire Challenge, L. Prix Louis de Guébriant - Grand Cross-Country de Craon

in overseas races*.

This only applies to horses which are less than 10yos, born & raised in France or assimilated, with an annual limit of €20,000 per horse (providing the purse is a minimum of €14.000). No age restriction in Group races.

+60% For 2 & 3 vos Owners Premiums * +45% For 4 & 5 yes A premium is distributed to owners of horses. born & raised in France or assimilated, in flat races which. unless mentioned in the race +35% For 6 yos + conditions, are not restricted to this category of horses. FLAT

FOR HORSES BORN BEFORE 2014:

in open races, where owners' premiums apply.

in races restricted to French-bred horses.

or French bred AQPS, Arab and Anglo Arab horses.

FOR HORSES BORN FROM 2014 ONWARDS:

Apply to horses that are less than 6yos, except in Group & Group PA** races where it applies whatever the age.

In all races except in Gr1& Gr1PA**

in open races*, where owners' premiums apply, for horses by a stallion based in France (otherwise 10%).

in races restricted to French-bred for horses by a stallion based in France (otherwise 14%).

for French bred AQPS, Arabs and Anglo Arab horses by a stallion based in France (otherwise 16%).

in overseas races*. This only applies to winners of Group races (part 1 International Cataloguing Standards & Group reserved to Purebred Arabians), with an annual limit of €15.000 per horse providing that horses are by a stallion based in France (otherwise 10%).
